The City of Rolling Hills Estates, in partnership with Waste Management, South Bay Environmental Services Center and Promenade on the Peninsula, is hosting its annual **Earth Day Celebration on Wednesday, April 22nd from 3 pm to 6 pm at the Promenade on the Peninsula.**

Located in the fountain area of the Promenade shopping center, the event will include paper shredding services, fun and educational activities, and giveaways for all.

The event will highlight great environmental initiatives around the community like Rancho Vista Elementary School's "Recycling for a Cause" Program and Palos Verdes Peninsula High School's "EarthWatch." Learn more about water conservation, stormwater pollution prevention, energy efficiency, and sustainable building.

NEW this year is an Environmental Art Contest for grades K-5. Art work should be aligned with this year's theme: "Taking the Greener Path." Art must be turned in at the Earth Day Celebration event on April 22 from 3 pm to 6 pm. The winner will be announced at the May 12 RHE City Council meeting and will receive a gift certificate to the Promenade on the Peninsula and a credit toward Martial Arts classes. All art will be displayed at the Promenade on the Peninsula Mall following the Earth Day Celebration Event.

3. Owners are responsible for their dog's behavior under all circumstances. (LACC 10.37.180)


First Saturday Family Hike
